Bill Analysis

SB 1649 requires the Attorney General to maintain data relating to human trafficking as well as provide assistance to law enforcement and social services relating to human trafficking, enter into memoranda of understanding with certain entities as needed, and prosecute criminal actions by information or indictment with all authority and responsibility otherwise provided by statute to district attorneys. The measure also repeals a provision of law relating to Attorney General duties.
