Bill Analysis

SB 1662 requires the Director of the Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation (OSBI) to develop procedures in accordance with the federal National Child Protection Act of 1993 and the federal Volunteers for Children Act to enable a qualified entity to request a state and national criminal history record check to determine whether a covered individual is the subject of any child abuse crime. Such a request shall be made by electronic submitting the fingerprints of the covered individual to the OSBI as directed by the authorized agency and submitting a copy of a statement signed by the covered individual that includes information outlined in the measure. Authorized agencies shall be required to obtain fingerprints from a covered individual and to submit the fingerprints to the OSBI and the FBI for a state and national criminal history record check.
