**Bill Analysis**

SB 1674 directs the Department of Environmental Quality to promulgate rules to regulate the construction of nuclear power plants. The measure requires any entity constructing a nuclear power plant to also construct a storage facility within the same ZIP code. Any entity seeking to construct a nuclear power plant shall be required to submit an application showing the projected dates for beginning and completing construction, the location of the future plant, copies of applications and correspondence with the federal Nuclear Regulatory Commission, statistics conveying the cost effectiveness and energy-saving possibility of the proposed facility, and other information deemed necessary by the Department.
