**Bill Analysis**

SB 1680 provides that lakes that join or abut upon a lake owned or leased by a municipality or by a public trust may be used or leased for amusement, parks, or recreation without abandoning or declaring such public property as surplus or unsuitable provided such use is a compatible contemporaneous use that is subordinate to the primary public purpose for which the lake or land was purchased or leased. Municipalities are authorized to contract with any person or entity to manage and operate such lakes and lands dedicated for a public purpose.
