## **Bill Analysis**

SB 1689 expands eligibility for a person to file for expungement to include persons convicted of not more than 1 nonviolent felony offense, who has completed their sentence, and paid any restitution ordered by the court. Additionally, such a person must have completed any treatment program ordered by the court. Any record that was expunged in this manner shall be unsealed if the person is subsequently convicted of a felony or misdemeanor.
