Bill Analysis

SB 1698 authorizes a physician, physician assistant, nurse, or other person employed by a registered hospice program to submit for destruction any unused quantity of controlled dangerous substances that were lawfully dispensed to a decedent prior to death. Employees requesting such destruction shall submit and complete a form as currently required of any group home or residential care home requesting destruction of controlled dangerous substances. The form shall also be signed by another employee of the hospice program or a family member of the decedent.
