**Bill Analysis**

SB 1706 directs the law enforcement officer to arrest the defendant who is the subject of a warrant issued prior to the final disposition of the criminal charge at issue or if the warrant is issued for negligent homicide, violation of a protective order, driving under the influence, driving while impaired, and any crime for which the victim is a minor. The measure provides that the defendant may be detained in the county of the defendant's apprehension for a reasonable period of time prior to transport. The defendant shall be transported by law enforcement from the county issuing the warrant to the county where the offense is triable as soon as practicable. The defendant in custody may be arraigned by the court in which the indictment or information for the arresting offense is filed by videoconference.
