**Bill Analysis**

SB 1735 provides that any person who enters into a restricted area of a commercial building without authorization shall be guilty of burglary in the second degree. The measure also provides that any person who forcibly bursts or breaks a wall, outer door, window, or shutter of a window in a commercial building shall be guilty of burglary in the first degree.
