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**Bill Analysis**

SB 1749 defines “referral agency” as it relates to the Continuum of Care and Assisted Living Act. The measure requires such an agency to disclose to prospective residents any documentation of potential relationship between the agency and the assisted living center, that the agency receives a fee from the assisted living center or continuum of care facility for the referral, and written documentation of the agreement between the referral agency and the prospective resident or representative of the prospective resident. The referral agency and the prospective resident shall sign a document with the information listed above contained on it and the facility shall maintain a written copy of the document . The facility is prohibited from selling the contact information of the prospective resident to a third party without their express written consent. Referral agencies found to have violated these provisions shall be subject to administrative penalties.

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
