## **Bill Analysis**

SB 1750 directs the Medical Marijuana Authority to create a registry of recommending physicians. To be eligible to recommend medical marijuana to patients, physicians must be registered with the Authority beginning January 1, 2025. The measure authorizes the Authority to enter into contracts and agreements for the payment for food, lodging, and other authorized expenses as may be necessary to host, conduct, sponsor, or participate in conferences, meetings, or training sessions. Additionally, the measure requires employees of medical marijuana dispensaries to comply with education and continuing education requirements promulgated by the Authority. The measure prohibits hosting or advertising medical marijuana-related events requiring admission fees or open to the general public, other than for the purposes of providing education to a physician on the list of approved providers and as permitted by the appropriate licensing board.
