Bill Analysis

SB 1752 modifies the qualifications for a self-funded or self-insured health care plan to participate in the Insure Oklahoma premium assistance program. It removes a time-limited requirement and shifts the qualifications from focusing on the health care plan to focusing on the employer that offers the plan. The measure also requires self-funded plans or self-insured health care plans to comply with all applicable federal laws including but not limited to the Employee Retirement Income Security Act of 1974 (ERISA). The measure also requires instead of authorizes the Insurance Department to recognize such plans for the purpose of participation in the premium assistance program.

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
