Bill Analysis

SB 1756 provides that a person who fails to complete or participate in any court-ordered substance abuse or mental health treatment and has their custody, guardianship, or visitation rights terminated as a result shall be considered by the court prior to determining the custody, guardianship, or visitation of a child. The measure also considers failure to complete such treatment as a rebuttable presumption that it is not in the best interests of the child to have custody or guardianship granted to such a person. The measure removes the ability of parties to waive the training requirements for persons monitoring court-order supervised visitation with a child.
