**Bill Analysis**

SB 1769 prohibits any foreign principal as defined in the measure from making a contribution or expenditure in support of or opposition to the election of any candidate to state or local office, ballot measure, referendum petition, or to any political action committee. The measure prohibits any candidate for state or local office from knowingly accepting such contributions. Upon a first violation, the contribution shall be forfeited to the Ethics Commission. Upon a second or subsequent violation, the candidate or political action committee shall forfeit the balance of any amounts in the candidate's or committee's campaign accounts to the Ethics Commission.
