Bill Analysis

SB 1790 strikes language prohibiting a person whose driving privileges were suspended in another country from being issued a driver license by Service Oklahoma. The measure also requires Service Oklahoma to provide clear and convincing evidence that a person cannot physically operate a vehicle. The measure authorizes applicants for a license to provide a medical self-certification that they are able to drive instead of medical information determined by the Service.
