Bill Analysis

SB 1806 authorizes the Department of Mental Health and Substance Abuse Services to coordinate and oversee the distribution of emergency opioid antagonists by state agencies. The measure provides that state agencies distributing emergency opioid antagonists shall execute an interagency agreement with the Department. Additionally, any agency or political subdivision that receives an opioid grant award under the Political Subdivisions Opioid Abatement Grants Act to purchase such antagonists shall submit data on the distribution, supply, and other information requested by the Department. The Department is directed to compile an annual report and submit it to the President Pro Tempore of the Senate, Speaker of the House, and Governor beginning December 1, 2025.
