Bill Analysis

SB 1841 provides that any person that attempts to remove feral swine from a landowner's property with the landowner's written permission shall not need to obtain a license to hunt wildlife or a permit to control wildlife. The measure also authorizes the use of a motor-driven land conveyance to pursue or follow feral swine, vehicle-mounted spotlights, and night-vision equipment. The measure repeals a law providing for a special permit to kill feral swine.
