Bill Analysis

SB 1852 provides that the chief of police shall be the chief law enforcement officer of a municipality. The measure also modifies the requirements to serve as the chief by requiring the officer to have served for a period of 5 years or more prior to assuming the position of chief law enforcement officer. The measure also requires such persons to complete the police chief administrative school offered by the Council on Law Enforcement Education Training (CLEET) and precludes such individuals from obtaining certification if they fail to complete the school. The measure also provides for the revocation of CLEET certification if a person who assumes the position of chief law enforcement officer already certified by CLEET fails to complete the school.
