Bill Analysis

SB 1855 provides that persons performing hair arranging services shall not be required to acquire a license under the Oklahoma Cosmetology and Barbering Act. Hair arranging shall include shampooing, conditioning, drying, arranging, curling, straightening, or styling hair using mechanical devices, hairsprays, and topical agents including, but not limited to, balms, oils, and serums. Hair arranging shall also include wigs and hair extensions. Hair arranging shall not include cutting hair as well as the application of dyes, bleach, reactive chemicals, keratin treatments, or other preparations for the coloring and altering of hair structure.
