Bill Analysis

SB 1858 directs a monument of the Ten Commandments to be prominently displayed and protected on the inside and outside of the Oklahoma State Capitol. The measure requires the President Pro Tempore of the Senate, Speaker of the House, and Governor to meet within 1 year of the effective date to determine the design, placement, security, construction, and funding of the monuments. The measure provides that only donated funds may be used for the design, placement, security, and construction of the monuments. Monuments may not be moved without 3/4 approval of the Legislature. The measure creates a felony for any person who knowingly causes damage or destruction to the monuments.
