Bill Analysis

SB 1868 requires all social media services offered in the state to preserve the privacy of residents and to not require any user to submit any proof of identification in order to use the social media service except for instances wherein the laws of this state have been violated. Violating any provision of this measure shall be considered a violation of the Oklahoma Consumer Protection Act.
