**Bill Analysis**

SB 1869 directs the State Department of Education to prepare a parental rights impact statement for any bill filed in the Senate or the House of Representatives that proposes changes to the rights of parents or legal guardians over students enrolled in a public school district or charter school. The measure allows the chairs of the legislative committees with responsibility over common education to request the impact statements, and it directs the statement to be filed prior to the deadline for consideration of bills by a committee in the house of origin. It also requires the impact statements to be posted on the legislative house of origin's legislation website.
