**Bill Analysis**

SB 1894 requires a school district board of education that chooses to use the superintendent search services of an organization or vendor to issue a request for proposals prior to entering into such a contract. The measure also requires a board of education to publicly disclose the names of the final 3 candidates being considered for the position of superintendent prior to entering into a contract with him or her. It also removes the requirement that a school district have an average daily membership of fewer than 500 students for a superintendent to also serve as a principal.
