**Bill Analysis**

SB 1908 creates a penalty for any person who enters any premises, easement, or right-of-way with the intent to steal or remove copper wire, copper cable, or copper tubing and the theft or removal causes damage. The measure provides that such persons shall be guilty of a felony and subject to a maximum term of imprisonment of 25 years and/or a maximum fine of \$50,000.00.
