Bill Analysis

SB 1934 requires harvesters of industrial hemp to harvest within 30 days of providing a sample of hemp that meets statutory levels of 0.3% tetrahydrocannabinol concentration. The measure provides that remediation of noncompliant hemp shall occur at the facility of the licensee. The measure also requires all key participants, as defined in the measure, to pass a criminal background check prior to licensure.
