**Bill Analysis**

SB 1942 provides that no more than 15% of the total land area within a county of this state shall be owned by an agency or entity of this state or the federal government, excluding Indian lands and military reservations. Any agency that owns more than 15% of the land area shall have 10 years to sell, transfer, trade, or otherwise dispose of land in order to reach the threshold. If more than 1 agency owns more than 15%, the affected agencies or entities shall enter into negotiations with the other affected agencies or entities to determine how to sell, transfer, trade, or otherwise dispose of the owned land.
