Bill Analysis

SB 1943 requires registrants engaged in the manufacture, distribution, dispensing, prescribing, administering, or use for scientific purposes of any controlled dangerous substance to annually register with the Director of the Oklahoma State Bureau of Narcotics and Dangerous Drugs Control. Each registrant must also disclose all beneficial owners of the registering entity. The measure strikes language requiring registrants of medical facilities to pay double the listed fee of registration for any renewal of registration received more than 30 days late. The measure also strikes language providing for a \$10.00 fee to produce a duplicate registration certificate. The measure also provides that the Director of the Oklahoma State Bureau of Narcotics and Dangerous Drugs Control shall promulgate rules necessary for registration application periods. Applications for renewal shall open on the first day of July and shall be considered timely if submitted on the first of September. Registrations not renewed by the final day of any calendar year in which the registration was issued shall be ineligible for renewal and shall require a new registration. The Director may waive this requirement if notice is provided prior to expiration.

House Amendments

HA's to SB 1943 adds language providing for registration dates as well as a waiver of the requirement to reregister if the entity failed to timely renew its registration.

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
