Bill Analysis

SB 1957 authorizes businesses to prohibit entry to any person occupying a place of business for the purpose of malicious occupation. A malicious occupation is an individual entering a place of business for noncommercial reasons, obstructing egress and ingress into the place of business, intimidating owners and customers, discouraging patronage, and diminishing business utility by encroaching, loitering, occupying, sleeping, camping, sitting, standing, or vandalizing for nonproductive or noncommercial purposes.
