Bill Analysis

SB 1968 provides that any person or entity authorized to be engaged in the production, manufacture, sale, or distribution of biosolids or sewage sludge to provide the required warning label information on any product generated or derived from biosolids or sewage sludge. The measure requires full disclosure to be given to any recipient, consumer, or purchaser of an agricultural crop or vegetative material that was produced at a location where biosolids or sewage sludge have been applied or permitted. Any permitted land application site that is sold or leased shall include a disclosure stating that the subject property was used as a biosolids or sewage sludge application site. The measure directs the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and Forestry to annually publish and update a map of biosolid and sewage sludge land application property sites. The measure directs the Department of Environmental Quality to prohibit the application of such products within 2 miles of a business conducting agritourism activity.
