Bill Analysis

SB 236 directs the State Board of Education to establish a grant program to provide public school districts and charter schools with grants to purchase an automated external defibrillator (AED), purchase parts or provide maintenance for an AED, provide training to school employees on the use of an AED, or provide cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) training for school employees. The bill states that implementation of the grant program is contingent on a legislative appropriation of \$500,000.00 for the specific purpose of the grant program. The measure directs the Board to submit a report on the grant program to the education committees of the Senate and House of Representatives.
