**Bill Analysis**

SB 278 modifies the Oklahoma Sunset Law. The measure provides that any statutory entity shall continue in existence until December 31 of the calendar year in which it is terminated for the sole purpose of ceasing its affairs. Additionally, such an entity shall only retain powers and responsibilities as needed to cease its affairs. Current law provides such an entity with a 1-year deadline to cease its affairs.
