Bill Analysis

SB 308 requires enterprises that receive funding from the Oklahoma Center for the Advancement of Science and Technology (OCAST) shall enter into a binding commitment to provide data annually through a survey provided by OCAST, in conjunction with the Commercialization Center. The commitment shall last 5 years or until the funding is repaid, whichever is later.
