Bill Analysis

SB 500 grants a leave of absence to any employee of the state upon the initial placement in his or her home of a child in the custody of the Department of Human Services. Such leave shall be capped at 10 days per year. Employees may take leave prior to the placement if an absence from work is required in order for the placement to proceed. Employees who take such leave shall be entitled to base state pay.
