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**Bill Analysis**

SB 612 requires background investigations to be conducted on every employee of the Oklahoma Lottery Commission. The measure also strikes language requiring the Commission to provide report regarding the impact of removing the requirement that net proceeds shall equal at least 35% of the gross proceeds. Additionally, the measure requires any person claiming a lottery prize greater than \$5,000.00 to provide the Commission with their name, address, social security number or tax identification number, proof of social security number or tax identification number, and sufficient valid identification prior to payment of the prize by the Commission. Such information shall not be subject to the Oklahoma Open Records Act and shall be kept confidential. The measure also repeals statutes providing for the creation of the Lottery Retailer Advisory Board and Oklahoma Lottery Commission Legislative Oversight Committee.
