Bill Analysis

SB 650 prohibits any person from using software to circumvent, thwart, interfere with, or evade a security measure, access control system, or other control measure on a ticket seller's Internet website as well as from selling software that is advertised for profit for the purpose of circumventing security measures. Any such violation shall be considered an unlawful business practice as it relates to the Oklahoma Consumer Protection Act. The CS also provides that a violation shall occur if the user or seller knows that use of the software led to the admission tickets being resold on the initial seller's Internet website or an Internet site used for the resell of admission tickets for a price above the admission ticket's initial cost.
