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**Bill Analysis**

SB 696 strikes the term “community partnership district” and its associated member from the Oklahoma Commission on Children and Youth. The measure modifies the duties of the Office of Planning and Coordination for Services to Children and Youth by requiring the State Plan for Services to Children and Youth to be planned 3 years in advance. The measure directs the Parent Partnership Board to assist the Commission in the process of developing and awarding grants supported by the Children’s Endowment Fund of Oklahoma. The measure extends the terms for members of a postadjudication review board to 5 years. The measure strikes language creating the State Postadjudication Review Advisory Board.
