Bill Analysis

SB 729 reestablishes the Oklahoma-Israel Exchange Commission. The Commission shall be located in Jerusalem and shall be comprised of 9 members. Members of the Commission appointed by the President Pro Tempore of the Senate, Speaker of the House, and Governor must be a representative of either an Oklahoma public institution of higher learning, the Israeli-American community in the state, an Oklahoman industry engaged in or seeking to engage in trade with Israel, or a trade association engaged in or seeking to engage in trade with Israel. Legislative members shall serve a 2-year term. The Commission shall promote trade, joint action on policy issues, exchanges, economic support, and other opportunities of mutual benefit. The Commission shall report its findings, activities, results, and recommendations to the President Pro Tempore of the Senate, Governor, and the Speaker of the House within 1 year of its initial meeting and by February 1 of each succeeding year.

House Amendments

HA's to SB 729 completely replaces engrossed language with the language described above.
