Bill Analysis

SB 830 directs county sheriffs, undersheriffs, and deputies to protect the people of their county from infringements of the rights guaranteed to the people by the Constitutions of the United States and Oklahoma and to prohibit agents, employees, and officers of the federal government from violating the rights of the people of their county. Sheriffs are authorized to organize posses for the performance of their duties. During such times of service, those under such call shall have all the privileges and immunities of the sheriff, undersheriff, and deputies.
