Bill Analysis

SB 924 prohibits public school districts and charter schools from using a program in grades kindergarten through second grade that uses the three-cueing system model of reading, visual memory as the primary basis for teaching word recognition, or the three-cueing system model based on meaning, structure, syntax, and visual. It directs the State Board of Education to notify a school if it is violating the prohibition, and if the violation is not remedied in 60 days, the bill directs the Board to withhold a maximum of 10% of the monthly State Aid distribution to the school. The measure directs the Board to contract with an education ombudsman to assist with enforcement.
