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## **Bill Analysis**

SB 931 expands the practice of pharmacy to include ordering, performing, and interpreting tests authorized by the Food and Drug Administration and waived under the federal Clinical Laboratory Improvement Amendments of 1988 as well as the initiation of drug therapy for minor, nonchronic health conditions. The measure also expands the practice to include the dispensing of self-administered hormonal contraceptives and any nicotine replacement therapy product that is approved by the United States Food and Drug Administration. The minor, nonchronic health conditions are outlined in the measure. Pharmacists may utilize such procedures starting January 1, 2024.

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
