Bill Analysis

SB 989 requires the Secretary of the State Election Board to direct the secretary of the election board of selected counties to conduct a post-election audit of election results upon the completion of certain elections. The post-election audits shall be conducted in a minimum of 3 randomly selected counties. The Secretary is authorized to promulgate rules relating only to the timing and method of the audit as it relates to the 3 randomly selected audits. All ballots shall receive a manual and electronic examination in such an audit. Any post-election audit conducted at the request of the Secretary may examine a limited number of ballots.
