Bill Analysis

SJR 35 submits to a vote of the people a constitutional amendment that implements a 12-year term limit for each Justice of the Oklahoma Supreme Court. A member may serve longer than the 12-year limit if he or she fills a vacancy for a partial term. Justices currently serving may finish their current term and then finish an additional 12 years.
