Title: Waters and water rights; creating the Waters and Water Rights Modernization Act; providing for noncodification; and providing an effective date.

Together with Engrossed Senate Amendments thereto, beg leave to report that we have had the same under consideration and herewith return the same with the following recommendations:

- 2. By adopting the following conference committee amendment to restore the title to read as follows:

An Act relating to waters and water rights; amending 82 O.S. 2021, Section 105.17, which relates to reversion of water to the public; requiring certain report by permit holders; allowing report to contain certain explanation; authorizing the Oklahoma Water Resources Board to promulgate certain rules; allowing for certain cancellation of permit; amending 82 O.S. 2021, Section 105.20, as amended by Section 1, Chapter 218, O.S.L. 2022 (82 O.S. Supp. 2023, Section 105.20), which relates to violations; authorizing the issuance of certain administrative orders upon findings; requiring orders make certain finding and specifications; and providing an effective date.

To the extent that the water authorized is 17 not put to beneficial use as provided by the terms of the permit, 18 that amount not so used shall be forfeited by the holder of the permit and shall become public water and available for 19 20 appropriation. 21 Β. When the party entitled to the use of water commences using 22 water but thereafter fails to beneficially use all or any part of 23 the water claimed by him or her, for which a right of use has been 24 vested for the purpose for which it was appropriated for a period of

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seven (7) continuous years, such unused water shall revert to the
public and shall be regarded as unappropriated public water.

C. Permit holders shall report their annual water use to the 3 4 Oklahoma Water Resources Board in a manner provided by the Board. 5 The water use report shall provide the permit holder an opportunity to explain any nonuse of the water allocated by the permit. In 6 7 addition to the procedure for individual proceedings provided for in Section 105.18 of this title, the Board is authorized to promulgate 8 9 rules for reporting stream water used and the approval of excused 10 nonuse of stream water. 11 D. Failure to report annual water usage may result in 12 cancellation of the permit by the Board upon proper notice and 13 hearing as provided in Section 105.18 of this title. 14 SECTION 2. AMENDATORY 82 O.S. 2021, Section 105.20, as

15 amended by Section 1, Chapter 218, O.S.L. 2022 (82 O.S. Supp. 2023, 16 Section 105.20), is amended to read as follows:

17 Section 105.20 A. The unauthorized use of water, the 18 unauthorized transfer of a water right, the continued use of works 19 which are unsafe after receiving notice to repair, the waste of 20 water, the unauthorized severance of a water right from the land to 21 which it is appurtenant, the refusal to change unsafe works when 22 directed to do so, the injury or obstruction of waterworks, or the 23 violation of a permit condition shall be a misdemeanor and each day 24 such violation continues shall be a separate violation. In addition

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1 to filing criminal complaints and any other remedies provided 2 herein, the Oklahoma Water Resources Board shall have the right to 3 bring an action in the district court of the county wherein such act 4 or omission occurs to enjoin the same.

5 Β. The unauthorized use of water, the unauthorized transfer of a water right, the continued use of works which are unsafe after 6 7 receiving notice to repair, the waste of water, the unauthorized severance of a water right from the land to which it is appurtenant, 8 9 the refusal to change unsafe works when directed to do so, the injury or obstruction of waterworks, or the violation of a permit 10 11 condition are considered violations of Sections 105.1 through 105.32 12 of this title and shall be subject to administrative penalties 13 issued by the Board of up to Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000.00) per 14 day of violation. Such administrative penalties shall be imposed 15 only after notice and opportunity for hearing on the proposed 16 imposition of such penalties.

17 C. The Board and its authorized agents shall have a reasonable 18 right to go upon private property in the performance of their duties 19 hereunder and shall have the duty to file complaints of violations 20 of the penal provisions of this section.

21 <u>D. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the Executive</u> 22 <u>Director of the Oklahoma Water Resources Board may issue</u> 23 <u>administrative orders requiring the immediate cessation of water use</u>

24 when Board staff has a reasonable belief the use is unauthorized or

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1	continued use will damage rights of prior appropriators. Such
2	administrative orders shall indicate the finding of imminent peril
3	and shall specify the actions that are to be taken immediately. In
4	addition, the orders shall specify a time and place for a hearing to
5	be held after such actions are taken.
6	SECTION 3. This act shall become effective November 1, 2024.
