21	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified						
22	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 2229.1C of Title 74, unless						
23	there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

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- A. By January 1, 2025, all properties held in fee title, lease or otherwise, including interests in land, real estate options, or real estate contracts designated for Hugo Lake Park are hereby transferred to the Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation Department.
- B. Appropriate conveyances and other documents shall be executed by January 1, 2025, to effectuate the transfer of Hugo Lake Park.
- C. The Department shall establish appropriate funds and accounts, including a revolving fund in the Office of Management and Enterprise Services, for servicing the fiscal operations of the park. Such funds and accounts shall be subject to the direct supervision, management, and control of the Department.
- D. The Department shall not be responsible for any claims arising under The Governmental Tort Claims Act accrued prior to January 1, 2025, claims arising from any other actions accrued prior to January 1, 2025, or tort claims arising prior to January 1, 2025, for which no claim has accrued upon the date of transfer. The Department shall not be responsible for any claims arising out of construction begun before January 1, 2025, at Hugo Lake Park.
- E. The Department shall promulgate the rules necessary for the transfer of property from Hugo Lake Park to the Oklahoma state park system.
