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1 the most recent version of the National Comprehensive a. 2 Cancer Network (NCCN) clinical practice recommendations that are level 2a or higher, 3 Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services national b. 4 5 coverage determinations or Medicare administrative contractor local coverage determinations, or 6 7 nationally recognized clinical practice guidelines; с. and 8

9 2. Evidence-based cancer imaging for individuals with an 10 increased risk of cancer when such test provides clinical utility 11 and when ordered or recommended by a health care provider in 12 accordance with the most recent version of the NCCN clinical 13 practice recommendations that are level 2a or higher, or in 14 accordance with other nationally recognized clinical practice 15 guidelines.

16 C. Coverage under this section shall not be subject to any 17 annual deductibles, copayments, or coinsurance limits as established 18 for all covered benefits under the health benefit plan.

D. If application of this section would result in health savings account ineligibility under Section 223 of the federal Internal Revenue Code, as amended, the provisions of this section shall only apply to health savings accounts with qualified high deductible health plans with respect to the deductible of such a plan after the enrollee has satisfied the minimum deductible.
