### **PROPOSAL:** <u>Amendatory</u>

HB 3240 proposes to require the Ad Valorem Division of the Oklahoma Tax Commission, upon request of the agency designated as the Census Bureau State Data Center, to furnish all location data and addresses necessary for the agency to complete its work with the United States Census Bureau.

EFFECTIVE DATE: November 1, 2024

### **REVENUE IMPACT:**

There is no impact to state tax collections.

### ADMINISTRATIVE IMPACT:

Currently, the Ad Valorem Division does not collect or house the information required to administer this proposal<sup>1</sup>. Additional statutory authority is necessary to obtain the information needed to administer the provisions of HB 3240. There would be administrative costs associated with efforts to obtain this information, however, a specific estimate of those costs is unknown at this time<sup>2</sup>.
