**Fiscal Analysis**

SB 1220 requires school districts to provide meals at no cost to certain children in certain years. OSDE does not collect data that would reflect the number of students who qualify for free/reduced meals based on income. When reviewing the paid meals for non-CEP/Provision schools in school year 2022-2023, the total paid lunches claimed by those schools is 13,499,905 multiplied by \$3.85 (the difference between the highest free lunch rate a school can get and the paid rate) is \$51,974,634. The total paid breakfast meals for the same period and same schools is 4,967,875 x \$2.35 (difference between the highest free breakfast rate a school can get and the paid rate) = \$11,674,506.
