## **PROPOSAL:** Amendatory

SB 1266 proposes to amend 62 O.S. § 46A, providing that all economic incentive provisions enacted, reauthorized or extended beyond the provided date of expiration after November 1, 2024, must include a measurable goal(s) and for an incentive claimed as a credit, the duration is limited to 10 or fewer years. The proposal further provides the following definitions:

- "Incentive" means any provision designed to benefit a business entity in the form of a credit, exemption, deduction, or rebate pertaining to a state tax liability of any kind, including a credit for an employee whose qualification is based on a specific degree, certification, or state license, or due to employment by an entity classified under a specific North American Industry Classification System code.
- "Measurable goal" means a statement about the expected long-term result of an incentive, intended for use as a foundation for data collection, comparison and evaluation.

**EFFECTIVE DATE:** November 1, 2024

## **REVENUE IMPACT:**

The revenue impact for a credit incentive enacted, authorized or extended after November 1, 2024, would be expected after the duration of the credit (limited to 10 years).
