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Fiscal Analysis

SB 1320 modifies the Empowered Schools and School Districts Act by prohibiting an empowerment plan from including collective bargaining agreements and requiring a plan to include a commitment to recruiting certain teachers. It also provides for salary increases for teachers with these certificates who are employed by an empowered school, zone, or district. It provides for a salary increase of at least \$6,000 for a teacher with an advanced certificate; an increase of at least \$10,000 for a teacher with a lead certificate; and an increase of at least \$20,000 but not more than \$40,000 for a teacher with a master certificate. There are no empowered school districts, so there is no fiscal impact. Currently, there are 10 Advanced, 18 Lead, and 5 Master teachers. Here is what it would cost IF those districts were empowered:

Advanced: 10 teachers X additional \$6,000 = \$60,000

Lead: 18 teachers X additional \$10,000 = \$180,000

Master: 5 teachers X additional \$20,000-\$40,000 = \$100,000-\$200,000
