Fiscal Analysis

SB 1322 would create a misdemeanor for assaulting a municipal, county, or state official who is in the lawful performance of his or her duties of employment. A person found guilty of this crime shall be subject to a term of imprisonment not to exceed 1 year and/or a maximum fine of \$1,000.00. The bill creates a felony for battery or assault and battery against such officials. A person found guilty of this crime shall be subject to a maximum term of imprisonment for 5 years and/or a maximum fine of \$5,000.00. The Department of Corrections is unable to determine the potential fiscal impact of this measure. The FY'23 incremental/average cost to incarcerate an inmate was \$6,811.85 annually or \$18.66 per day.
