**Fiscal Analysis**

SB 1328 modifies eligibility for OHLAP (Oklahoma's Promise). It provides eligibility for students who have completed a core curriculum and seek admission to a technology center school. Estimate are that this change might benefit about 200 students from each high school graduating class. Following are estimated annual costs for the first five years, which would begin with FY2025 (2024 high school graduates). After the fifth year, costs should stabilize except for increases in tuition rates.

FY2025 - \$480,000  
FY2026 - \$750,000  
FY2027 - \$920,000  
FY2028 - \$1,030,000  
FY2029 - \$1,100,000
